## ABOUT US

Our mission at the Ontario Wheelchair Sports Association (OWSA) is to grow wheelchair sport opportunities across Ontario. As the governing body for wheelchair sports in the province, we strive to offer opportunities for athletes with disabilities to participate in wheelchair athletics, wheelchair basketball, wheelchair rugby and wheelchair tennis at recreational, competitive and high performance levels.

The OWSA is also the provincial delivery agent for Bridging the Gap – a national education and outreach program designed to introduce people of all abilities to wheelchair sports. Our provincial coordinator will bring sport wheelchairs and all required equipment to rehabilitation hospitals, schools and community events to run “Have a Go” days. These events give everyone the opportunity to try out our sports. Athletes new to wheelchair sports can rent a sport wheelchair from us for a low monthly fee, to ensure the cost of equipment is not a barrier to participation.

**BOUNCE BACK AND REBOUND** is the ultimate team building challenge for you and your colleagues. A 3-on-3 wheelchair basketball tournament with two clear goals:

1. **Raise funds and awareness for people in Ontario with spinal cord injury**
2. **Win!**

### TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Before they take to the court, Bounce Back and Rebound teams will be coached during a warm-up by a highly skilled wheelchair basketball athlete. Teams can consist of 4-6 players. Each half-court game will be approximately 10 minutes long, with three games guaranteed for each team.

There will be food and drinks available and a raffle to help us raise those extra dollars!

We'll round off the evening with an awards ceremony to see which team will be crowned Kings and Queens of the Court.
